

Terms of Use

Among the uses that are considered unacceptable and which constitute a violation of this policy are the following:

1. Uses that violate the law or encourage others to violate the law.
Transmitting of offensive or harassing messages; offering for sale or use any substance the possession or use of which is prohibited by law; viewing, transmitting or downloading pornographic materials or materials that encourage other to violate the law; downloading or transmitting of confidential, trade secret information, or copyrighted materials. Even if materials on the networks are not marked with the copyright symbol, users should assume that all materials are protected unless there is explicit permission on the materials to use them.
2. Uses that cause harm to others or damage to their property.
Engaging in defamation (harming another's reputation by lies); uploading a worm, virus, "Trojan horse," "time bomb," or other harmful form of programming or vandalism; participating in "hacking" activities or any form of unauthorized access to other computers, networks, or information systems.
3. Uses that compromise the safety and security of minors when using e-mail, chat rooms and other forms of direct electronic communications:
Minors under age 18: Giving others private information about one's self or others, including credit card numbers and social security numbers; arranging a face-to-face meeting with someone one has "met" on the computer network or Internet without a parent's permission.

By purchasing a Hot Spot Internet Pass Card, you are agreeing to the **Terms of Use** and are subject to its entire dictum.

In order to utilize the Internet capabilities of the Hot Spot, you will need a laptop with an 802.3b compatible wireless Ethernet card, or an 802.3 Ethernet card with a sufficient length of Cat 5 cable. These things will not be provided for you, nor they be installed, or repaired. It is your responsibility to have an Internet capable computer with the appropriate drivers installed. If your computer cannot connect to the Hot Spot network your money will be refunded; however, if you are removed from the network for violating the **Terms of Use** (see above), you will not receive a refund, and future access will not be permitted.

Connecting to Hot Spot Wireless Network

Windows XP and 2000 instructions ONLY

1. Purchase a Hot Spot Internet Pass Card from Hot Spot Staff. Each hour of internet access costs \$5.00.
2. Turn on laptop and log in to user account.
3. Click on Start>Settings>Network Connections, right click on Wireless Network Connection, and select View Available Wireless Networks.

For a non-wireless connection plug in the Ethernet cable and click on Start>Settings>Network Connections. Right-click on Local Area Connection and select Properties. Scroll to the bottom and double-click on Internet Protocol (TCP/IP). Verify that Obtain an IP address automatically, and Obtain the DNS server address automatically are checked. Skip step 4.

4. Select HotSpotInternet (not HotSpot) in the Network key, and Confirm network key field input the password located on the Hot Spot Internet Pass Card.
5. If the procedure did not work correctly, or your computer does not run Windows 2000/Windows XP, please contact our staff for more assistance.
